

MASTER PROGRAMMES @ GHENT UNIVERSITY

Graduates from Ghent University Global Campus (GUGC) can continue their education at Ghent University home campus.

Depending from the programme, GUGC graduates have direct admission (D), are admitted subject to a preparatory course (P), or subject to an enquiry into the suitability (S).

The following master programmes are available in study domains related to the GUGC bachelor's programmes:

For graduates from all GUGC Bachelor programmes:

- International Master of Science in Agro- and Environmental Nematology (D)
- Master of Science in Business Engineering Data Analytics (P)
- Master of Science in Environmental Science and Technology (D) (Former Master of Science in Environmental Sanitation)

For graduated Bachelors in Food Technology:

Master of Science in Nutrition and Rural Development (D)

For graduated Bachelors in Molecular Biotechnology:

- Master of Science in Biochemistry and Biotechnology (D)
- Master of Science in Bio-informatics: Bioscience Engineering (D)
- Master of Science in Bio-informatics: Systems Biology (D)
- Master of Science in Bioscience Engineering: Cell and Gene Biotechnology (D)

Students from GUGC can apply for exemptions with the curriculum committee of the programme for which they enrol.

GUGC graduates can enrol directly via <u>oasis.ugent.be</u> and are not required to follow the Ghent University admission procedure and deadlines for international students.

However, timely application is advised (4 to 6 months before the start of the academic year) in view of visa, scholarship or housing application. For this purpose, applicants receive a letter of admittance.
